The **Girls' Leadership CouncilSM** (GLC) is a dynamic, one-week program designed by The Women's Foundation of Colorado (WFCO) to inspire and empower **high school sophomore girls** to create positive changes in their communities through leadership, advocacy, and philanthropy.

Following a competitive application and interview process, we will invite 20 girls entering their junior years to participate in our life-changing program at the University of Denver (DU) campus in summer of 2016.

Workshops and discussions led by expert guest speakers will expose you to important topics, such as:

- Succeeding in STEM Careers
- The Value of Diversity and Inclusiveness
- Creating Change: You Can Do It!
- Networking 101
- What Makes a Philanthropist?
- · Becoming an Effective Decision Maker

At the end of the week, you will use the skills you've acquired to participate in a one-of-a-kind opportunity in which the Girls' Leadership Council will make a community investment as a group to one or more nonprofit organizations.
