January 2017 - February 2017	The GLC opportunity is advertised to schools and organizations across Colorado.
March 1, 2017 5:00 pm	APPLICATION DEADLINE <i>NOTE: The application must be e-mailed or arrive at Girls Inc. of Metro Denver by 5:00 p.m. Mountain Standard Time on March 1, 2017. Please see application guidelines for further details.</i>
March 1 – mid-March 2017	APPLICATION REVIEW – Staff reviews applications and distributes to the volunteer community reviewers for review and assessment. FINALIST SELECTION – Staff will compile reviewer data and select finalists the week of March 20, 2017. FOLLOW-UP WITH APPLICANTS - All applicants will be notified of their status on March 24, 2017. Notice will be given via email and finalists will be contacted via phone.
April 8, 2017	PHONE INTERVIEWS - Saturday, April 8, 2017 35 finalists will be interviewed. Twenty candidates will be chosen for participation in the program. <i>NOTE: Finalists will be notified of their selection status by Friday, April 21, 2017 via phone.</i>
May 6, 2017 9:00am – 5:00pm	ORIENTATION - Finalists and Parent/Guardians must attend. Participants will learn about GLC week and the Community Leadership Project
June 19, 2017 5:00-6:00pm	WEBINAR #1 – Participants will prepare for their Community Leadership Projects in hour long virtual trainings.
July 10, 2017 5:00-6:00pm	WEBINAR #2 – Participants will prepare for their Community Leadership Projects in hour long virtual trainings.
July 23 – July 29, 2017	GIRLS' LEADERSHIP COUNCIL CONVENES
July 23, 2017	CHECK IN at 10:00 a.m. with Noon Orientation for participants and parents/guardians
July 29, 2017, 12:00pm – 3:00pm	GLC SHOWCASE - Event for participants, families and guests displaying Community Leadership Projects
